# Shareholders agreement – Setting expectations among shareholders, especially minority shareholders

- Who is in charge of the company's business?
- Should there be limitations on the director's powers?
- Should the directors be legally obligated to declare dividends on shares held by:
  - » non-directors?
  - » minority shareholders?
  - » non-voting shareholders?



## Shareholders agreement – exit strategies

- Inside buyers
  - » Classic shotgun buy/sell
  - "Put" option
- Outside buyers
  - » Right of first refusal (ROFR rights)
  - » Piggy back rights
  - » Tag-along rights



## Shareholders agreement – exit strategies (cont'd)

- Share sale on death or disability
  - » Life Insurance issues
  - » Financing the buy-out
  - » Share valuation challenges





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
